Now is the time to start thinking about the Fall Rendezvous scheduled for October 25-28, 2002. This is the council service that the Mandan Lodge provides for Santa Fe Trail Council. All Scouts are invited to attend the weekend outing. Registration is due to the council office by October 18. Cub Scouts are invited for Saturday and troops are encouraged to invite the Webelos to spend the weekend with them cooking and camping.

Each chapter is encouraged to get a contingent together to attend the conclave at Quivera Scout Ranch on September 20-22. The Mickey's will be taking a van leaving from the Methodist Church on Friday. Remember all drivers must file a tour permit with the council or notify Charles Mickey and he will fill out the forms. He will also be in charge of maps, schedules, etc. Pre-registration is a must. The cost of the conclave is \$35.00. No individual walk-ins will be accepted. This is necessary for the host Lodge to prepare food. Meals provided are two cracker barrels, two breakfasts, one lunch and one dinner.
